

GENERAL GUIDELINES

Revised on October 9, 2007

The purpose of these guidelines, are to set standards for Live-aboard status within the PAYC.

- **Must be a current member in good standing.**
- **PAYC reserves the right to refuse live-aboard status or terminate live-aboard status based on violation of existing guidelines, PIC regulations and club by-laws.**
- **Provide proof of boat ownership.**
- **30' minimum length of boat recommended, self contained (full galley, head w/holding tank, hot water heater, stove and shower). Must be capable of live-aboard status as deemed by the board of PAYC. Number of occupants, as per board decision.**
- **Live-aboard status only in 30 amp electrically metered slip, as per PAYC.**
- **Said vessel will have passed a USCG Auxiliary Safe Boating Check within 15 days of completion of the Application of Live-aboard form.**
- **Hurricane preparedness worksheets shall be completed and returned to the PAYC Harbormaster prior to approval of Live-aboard status.**
- **The current harbor master of PAYC or designee of the board shall inspect the vessel of the individual submitting an application of live-aboard status to assure compliance and report to the board for approval or disapproval. (Live-aboard status will not be granted until all guidelines are met).**
- **Signature of a majority of board members required and approved by the majority of the board and the at a regular board meeting.**
- **The PIC (Pleasure Island Commission) Pleasure Boat Slip Agreement shall be abided to.**
- **Four night per week or sixteen nights per month spent aboard constitutes live-aboard status, as per PIC marina regulations.**
- **PIC monthly slip and electrical fees and PAYC dues are to be paid on time and in full or live-aboard status will be revoked.**

- Proper marine approved electrical cords required due to fire hazard. No household type electrical cords/plugs from power supply to boat.
(Non-approved household type electrical cords are a fire hazard!)
- USCG approved portable fire extinguishers required as per 46 CFR and properly mounted aboard your vessel.
- Waste (*blackwater*) holding tanks shall be used and emptied at the PIC Pump-Out Station or as federal law requires.
- Keep your slip, dock box (stowage in dock box only)(only approved dock boxes) and bulkhead area clean and liter free.
- Two car parking limit in front of your slip, overflow guest parking at club house.
- **BE ACCOUNTABLE FOR YOU AND YOUR GUEST ACTIONS.**
- Observe quiet hours (2200 hrs to 0800 hrs).
- Live-aboards should be proactive in PAYC facility safety and security.
(Discussion of safety/security program)
- Remove from PAYC property all by-products from fish cleaning.
(DO NOT DISPOSE OF IN MARINA.)
- Pick up after your pet(s).
- Share your ideas of possible improvement(s) with the board and assist with same.
- If an alligator is in the marina, notify PIC. **DO NOT HARM OR KILL THE ALLIGATOR.** . . Call PIC, they will inform the State Wildlife Commission for removal.
- Said vessel shall be maintained in operational status.
